## 2023 YEAR IN REVIEW

Mission Statement: Downtown Wytheville is building grassroots revitalization, forging strong partnerships, and implementing progressive strategies to realize its vision of making Downtown Wytheville the vibrant heart of community and commerce for the region.

In 2023, Downtown Wytheville continued building a strong sense of community through small business development and trainings, technical support, infrastructure upgrades, collaborative engagement, and events that bring people together.

In particular, we administered the Grow with Google program, in partnership with Main Street America and Google. Through the efforts of our Grow with Google coach, DTW staff, volunteers, and partners throughout the region, we taught digital skills to rural businesses and entrepreneurs around Southwest Virginia and across the entire state becoming the most successful of the 10 selected communities in the nation reaching nearly 1,810 participants.

We also continued working to develop engaging public places and green spaces that bring locals and visitors alike together, increase foot traffic downtown, and increase quality of life for residents. Through this effort, we formed a partnership with the Virginia Tech Landscape Architecture School to take a fresh look at our parks and vacant spaces as part of student coursework. We have generated architectural plans from this process and we have received grant funding and private donations to begin implementing some of these designs including a new pocket park greenspace on a vacant lot in the heart of downtown. We still lack about 25% of the funding to begin this first project and are continuing to explore funding to begin construction in 2024.

Finally, we continued expanding our popular community events like the Downtown Wytheville 4th of July Celebration & Street Festival, Mayhem on Main Street, and the Christmas Parade Celebration. All of our events in 2023 saw record attendance and participation from businesses with the 4th of July Celebration setting a record as the largest single-day event in Wytheville's history with over 12,500 visitors. We also expanded our efforts to spur more business-driven events throughout the year by encouraging inter-business collaboration. As part of this effort, we have launched a successful marketing campaign to promote all the great new things going on in Downtown Wytheville on any given night to counter narratives that "there's nothing going on". This Weekends in Wytheville campaign has been one of the most popular and engaging marketing promotions we've done as an organization and regularly reaches a large audience of Wythe County residents and visitors.

We look forward to continuing the progress made in 2023 and expanding into new areas throughout 2024.



# OUR 2024 PROJECTS

### Grow with Google

### Continuing virtual trainings and workshops for businesses

Because Downtown Wytheville has been the most successful of the 10 pilot communities in the Grow with Google program, Google, Main Street America, and the DTW Board of Directors have allowed us to continue trainings for the first half of 2024 with an increased focus on in-person workshops in Wytheville. We also plan to continue and expand these trainings even after the program ends in March 2024.



Providing relief to small businesses through lower utility costs from energy efficiency upgrades

Creating a sustainable small business environment is important to the vitality of our community, but rising utility costs have become one of the chief burdens facing business owners. Through a Virginia Main Street grant, we will be incentivizing downtown property owners to make major energy efficiency upgrades, that can include solar panels, to help lower the cost of doing business and keep our local businesses sustainable.

## VI VIRGINIA TECH

#### Implementing community-driven, studentgenerated designs for interactive greenspaces downtown

For the past year, Downtown Wytheville has formed a partnership with the Virginia Tech School of Landscape Architecture where their students have spent a fieldwork course talking with locals and generating new designs for both the downtown pocket park and upgrades to existing public spaces like Elizabeth Brown, Withers, and more. We have already secured grant and private funding to cover 75% of the cost of the pocket park and are pursuing the final piece of funding. We intend to begin construction on the pocket park this year with a grand opening to follow, and we are actively pursuing additional funding to implement design suggestions for other spaces.



Enhancing downtown spaces to promote downtown living, cultural arts, walkability, and bikeability.

In 2023, the National Association of Realtors found that 79% of people considered living within an easy walk of other places and things like shops and parks very important. We intend to partner with the Town of Wytheville and other groups to continue expanding downtown living options, making neighborhoods more walkable/bikeable to downtown, and enhancing the district with more music, art, and events that make it a central destination for residents and tourists.

### **Carriage Rides**

Each year we offer carriage rides for children and families. Your partnership will help offset rental costs allowing us to continue offering this and other elements as part of the event in the future.

### **Visit with Santa**

### Christmas Parade

The Christmas parade has become a staple in our community. Downtown Wytheville board members and volunteers plan, coordinate and execute this event along with various community partners.



### Wytheville's Christmas Celebration & Parade

The Downtown Wytheville Christmas Celebration & Parade is a true old fashioned hometown Christmas event. Downtown Wytheville becomes a winter wonderland with decorations, lit up storefront Christmas themed windows, and coffee or hot chocolate readily available. This event builds on our sense of place and community for our residents to gather and enjoy each others' company and kick of the holiday season in Wytheville. We kick off the event in Withers park during the day with carriage rides, visit with Santa, kids crafts and activities. Depending on funds, we will continue to add live music and other holiday features that will benefit the children and families in our community.

### **Additional Funds Needed**

To substantially start and complete the project. We are about 25% short on our funding. As we await additional grant announcements, please reach out to us about how your contribution can directly assist us in completing this project

We envision this space doubling as an outdoor co-working space where residents set up and work here while enjoying all that this park has to offer

### **Community Creative Space**

Families and children are critical to how this space interacts with the community and programming throughout the year will reflect those goals.



Through a new grant program, Downtown property owners can receive up to \$10,000 in support towards adding solar or wind arrays to their property helping offset rising electricity costs and lower our carbon footprint.

### **Energy Efficiency**

Property owners can also get anywhere from \$2,500 to \$5,000 towards energy efficiency upgrades to aging buildings helping lower utility bills for small businesses.

### **Leading the Way**

This is a true pilot program testing how Main Streets can be at the forefront of the coming changes in the energy sector. We want Wytheville to be a model example and lead the way for more projects like this locally and across Southwestern Virginia. As more and more grants, tax credits, and incentives appear on the horizon for green energy upgrades, this pilot program will set our community up for additional resources and support. Our partners will be prominently featured in this program showcasing their commitment to forward-thinking solutions.

Downtown Wytheville was fortunate to receive a Downtown Resurgence Grant from Virginia Main Street which we will be administering throughout 2024. We regularly talk with business owners throughout our district about the challenges they face and one of the most common hardships are utility costs. Rising costs combined with inefficient downtown buildings make some of these bills a significant hurdle for new entrepreneurs. Through this program, we will be incentivizing property owners to not only explore major solutions like solar and wind arrays, but smaller changes as well that can increase energy efficiency. Any savings from these upgrades are passed along to the small businesses making them more sustainable and providing yet another incentive for why the place to live, work, and do business in Wytheville is downtown.

# **Extending Trainings through March 2024**

Due to the success of the program, sessions will be extended through March 2024.

In 2023 an innovative new partnership between Main Street America and Google was launched to bring digital skills trainings to rural businesses across the country. As part of this new pilot program, Downtown Wytheville Incorporated was selected as 1 of 10 organizations to represent not only our hometown and Southwest Virginia but the entire Commonwealth of Virginia in bringing digital skills training to small, rural businesses. During the pandemic, we found out just how important e-commerce and virtual integration are to the success of a business; however, small businesses in rural areas have less experience with this "bricks and clicks" model. This new Grow with Google training program begins addressing this through new resources, one-on-one assistance, and in-person and virtual classes taught by our local Grow with Google coach, Courtney Conner-Stringer.
